



# Year 5 SPRING

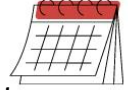


The Year 5 teachers are Mr Burch and Mr Harvey, who are supported by Mrs Green and Miss Lotani.

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## Reading



We have a range of core texts this term:

A Midsummer Night's Dream, I Am Not A Label, Boy in the Tower, and Daffodils by William Wordsworth.

## Writing



During the Spring Term we will be writing a character description, an explanation text, using a video to retell part of a story, a non-chronological report and revisiting grammar knowledge.

## Maths



We will continue to focus on a range of mathematical skills: number and place value, written methods, fractions/decimals/percentages, geometry, measures and statistics.

## Science



We will be learning about Earth and Space, including celestial bodies and the solar system.

## Geography and History

We will focus on developing our historical and geographical skills through comparing Ipswich to our twinned town of Arras.



## Computing

We will be developing our knowledge of coding and spreadsheets.



## Art & DT

In Art, the children will develop their knowledge of printing and textiles and collage. In DT the children will design a mezze and also focus on pulleys.



## Music

The children will continue learning new Ukulele chords and strumming patterns, as well as developing our musical performance skills and notation knowledge.



## PSHE and Religion & Worldviews:

Our PSHE units are 'Dreams & Goals' and 'Healthy Me'. Our RW units are 'The 8-fold path' in Buddhism and 'Salvation' in Christianity.
