

SUMMER







We shall be using the books 'Varjak Paw' and 'The Girl Who Stole An Elephant' and a range of texts connected to these, to develop our fluency, retrieval and inference skills. We will also use texts connected to rainforests.

Maths



We will continue to develop our knowledge of place value, written methods for all operations (+,-,x, $\div)$, fractions and decimals. We will be developing these skills through more challenging questions where we need to identify what methods will help us.

History/Geography

We will be learning about rainforests: where you would find them, what it is like within them and human impact.

We will develop a range of techniques to create backgrounds and then apply this to rainforest images.

PSHE and RW

We will be looking at relationships and how we change as we get older.

Writing

We will be honing our writing skills and developing our use of fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases and (for some) using relative clauses to add more precision to our writing. We will be using our rainforests topic and trips as influences.

Science

We will be looking at living things and habitats, and the impact of changes in our local environment on living things. We will then learn about electricity and create our own circuits, before applying this to making a buzzer game in DT.

Computing

We will be looking at improving our skills using PowerPoint and Microsoft Word to record our ideas ahead of presenting them.

Music

We will continue to develop our knowledge of beats and rhythms whilst learning composition and notation skills.

PE

We will be improving our hitting and catching skills in rounders, while also developing our knowledge and abilities in athletics.
