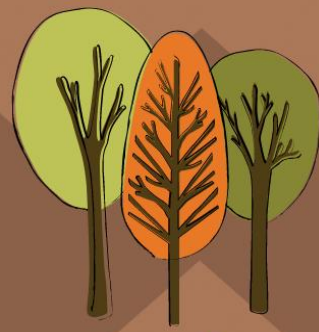




Year 6

PE

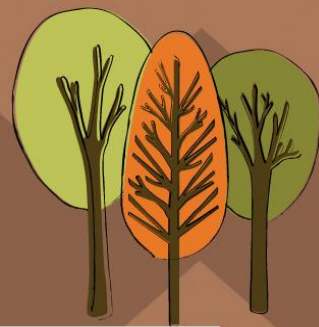
We will be building on our invasion games skills through basketball along with swimming.

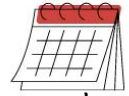


The Year 6 teachers are Miss Binge and Miss Dade.
