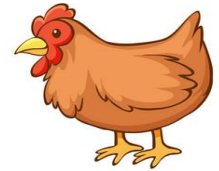
Maths

4. Olaf catches snowflakes to a ratio of 2:3 - for every 2 he catches, he misses 3. In one month, Olaf catches 42 snowflakes. How many does he miss?



5. Dory is very forgetful. The ratio of things remembered to not remembered is 1:4. If Dory remembers 6 things, how many things has she not remembered?
