Maths	Today you will be thinking about how to apply your understanding of area and perimeter to a variety of reasoning questions. Spellings	Have a look at this week's spelling words and practise these in whichever way works best for you. You could try writing them out as much as you can, a spelling scribble, a spelling pyramid or make a spelling game.	
Music	Practise what you have learnt so far on your clarinet - maybe you could even put on a show for the people you live with.
